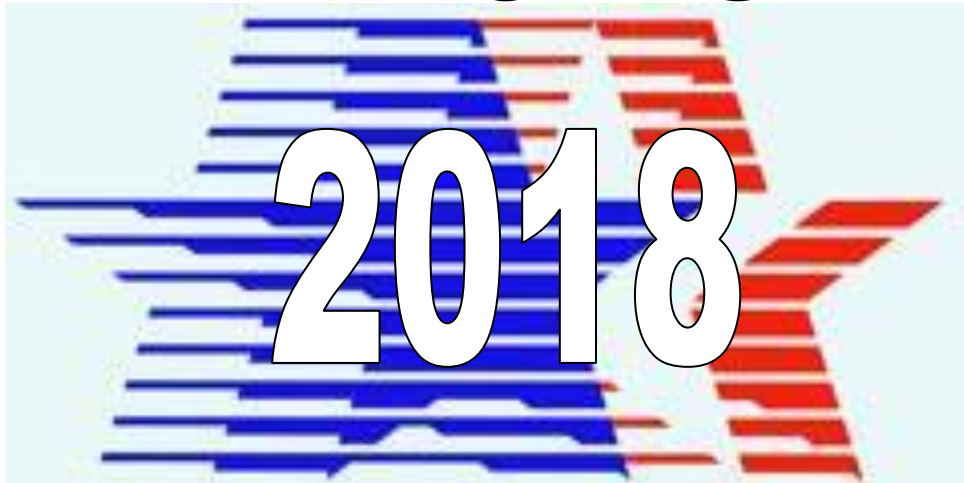

Sabre - Student Under 18, Born 2000 or After

Registration 08:30am – 09:00am, Opening Ceremony 09:00am; Competition Start 09:15am

Foil - Students Under 18, Born 2000 or After – Foil

Registration 09:45am – 10:15am; Opening Ceremony 10:15am; Competition Start 10:30am

Epee - Students Under 18, Born 2000 or After - Epee

Event Format: Separation by gender whenever possible. Maxi-fence (2 rounds of pools).

Depending upon numbers the Organisor may modify format and categories.

Clothing: 350N Jacket and Plastron, fencing breeches/long socks or long sport pants.

Chest protectors for girls. FIE blades and lame bibs NOT required.

For Under 13 fencers we recommended using size 3 or smaller blades (Under 11 size 0), which are more suited to their hands & size (easier to manipulate), than the adult size 5.
