## Equipment Requirements

- white fencing jacket and plastron (CE350N)
- Chest protector for girls is obligatory
- Fencing breeches (CE350) Long track pants are accepted. Shorts are not accepted
- Fencing glove
- Mask with elastic strap across back. Metallic bib not required ( CE350N)
- Body wires
- Metallic vest (sometimes called lame jacket)
- Electric foils

**Requirments: Secondary school students. ( Year 9 to Year 13)**

**1. Beginners event: 1<sup>st</sup> year fencing (starts fencing in 2015)**

**2. Intermediate event: 2<sup>nd</sup> year fencing or above and never won any 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>= place in Regional or NZ Tournaments.**

**Format: 1 round of pools followed by Direct elimination and if numbers permit separate men and women events. 6+ of each gender will be required, any less the event will be mixed**

**Medals: will be presented to the top 4 ( 1<sup>st</sup> , 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>=) fencers in each event.**

Events will be mixed (male and female ) unless min. 6 fencers in each genders will run a separate events.
